



- c Nominations can be received up to and until the time of the elections. Nominations need to be agreed by the member being nominated and need to be proposed. If total nominations exceed vacancies, election shall be by ballot.
  - d Where exceptional circumstance make it impractical to hold the AGM on the date prescribed by sub-section (a) it may be held as soon as reasonably practical afterwards provided that at least 14 days' notice is given of the date.
- 8 Special General Meeting
 

A Special General Meeting of the Club shall be called at 14 days' clear notice in writing upon the written demand of six members, or by the Chairman, or Vice-Chairman acting in his/her absence, or by the Committee.
- 9 Quorum
  - a For any Annual General Meeting or Special General Meeting to be quorate, one third of the membership should be present unless arrangements have been made for all members to be able to vote even if not present. In the latter case members should be sent the papers for the meeting, including all matters to be decided, at least 14 days before the date of the meeting.
  - b A quorum at meetings of the Committee shall be one third of the Committee membership, to include the Chairman or Vice-Chairman.
- 10 Finance
  - a The Club may obtain, collect and receive money by way of subscriptions, fees, sales, donations, legacies, grants and other lawful income, and may receive gifts of intellectual and other property.
  - b The income and property of the Club shall be applied for the purposes of the Club as set out in this Constitution.
  - c The records of income and expenditure shall be subject to annual audit.
  - d The financial year shall be from the first day of August until the 31st day of July.
- 11 Subscriptions and Fees
 

The Subscriptions and Fees shall be determined annually by the Committee before the Annual General Meeting.
- 12 Amendment
 

This Constitution may be amended only at an Annual or Special General Meeting and any proposed amendments must be notified in advance as part of the Agenda.
- 13. Dissolution
 

In the event of the winding up of the Club, the surplus funds shall be offered to Radley Primary School or otherwise to Radley Parish Council or to a charitable institution at the discretion of the members, and the records and archives shall be offered first to the Berkshire Record Office or otherwise to some other local repository.
